3. What are you most proud of?

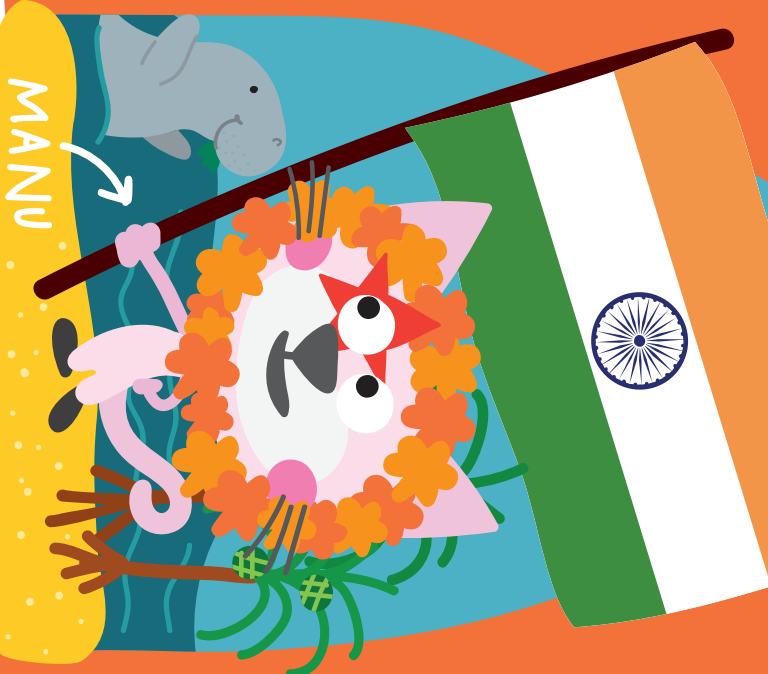
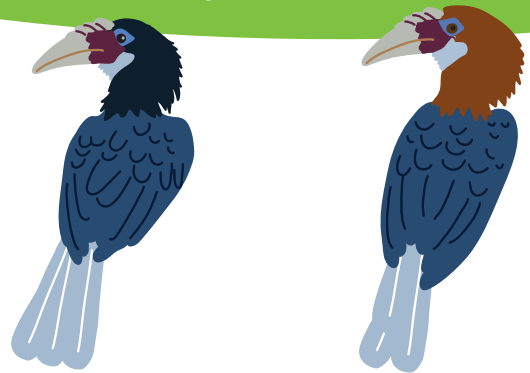
I LOVE dugongs! Can you work out which of these statements are TRUE and which are FALSE?

## WITH YOUR GROWN UP!!!

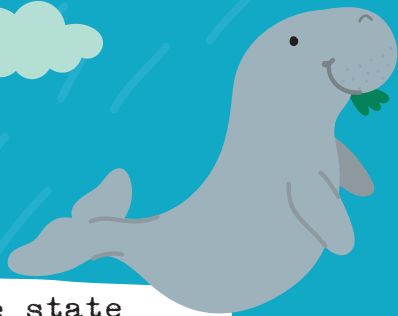
